 Use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters
 Increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting
Compositional skills
 In narratives, create settings, characters and plot (KPI)
 Write effectively and coherently for different purposes, drawing on reading to inform
vocabulary and grammar of their writing
 Organise paragraphs around a theme (KPI) Use headings and sub-headings to aid presentation (KPI) Plan, draft, write, evaluate and edit writing with simple notes
