Statement of the Values and Ethos of Wheatcroft CP School

Learning

We will support and challenge every child to do their best across the whole curriculum, achieving the highest standards of which each is capable. We will develop resilience and a positive self-belief.

- Contact parents if there are any concerns with the progress, social behaviour, attendance or discipline of their child
- Act upon any disclosures in the area of child protection and follow the school's Safeguarding Procedure.
- Keep parents informed about school activities and achievements through regular newsletters and the school website
- Issue a prospectus detailing school policies and procedures
- Set and monitor homework in line with the Government's policy on homework

The Parents/Carers:

- I/We will encourage my child to be enthusiastic about their learning, to work hard and to have high aspirations
- I/We will support learning at home and homework tasks
- I/We will attend parents' evenings and any other meetings the School has to inform parents of new policies in education and support the work of the school
