



Linked learning theme: Year 5 – Autumn 2

Computing – Creating media – Video production

Prior Learning

- During this unit, learners will develop their skills gained in the Year 3 unit, Stop-frame animation, and the Year 4 unit, Audio production. They will further explore how to develop consistency in their product and how to add effects and edit their product to achieve a purpose.

Core knowledge

Learners will learn how to create short videos by working in pairs or groups. As they progress through this unit, they will be exposed to topic-based language and develop the skills of capturing, editing, and manipulating video. Learners are guided with step-by-step support to take their idea from conception to completion. At the conclusion of the unit, learners have the opportunity to reflect on and assess their progress in creating a video.

- Analyse and compare different forms of video.
- Experiment with how filming techniques can alter purpose.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of a range of videoing techniques.
- Use storyboards to plan purposeful filming projects.
- Review, edit and reshoot video for improvement.
- Reorder media.
- Export data from one form to another.
