



Linked learning theme: All You Can Eat

Summer term, Year 3

Design & Technology – Textiles

Prior knowledge

In Year 2, children have made a Christmas stocking. They have used sewing and gluing techniques to attach materials.

Core knowledge

- Running stitch will attach two pieces of material together.
- Materials with different textures can be used to create different looks.
- Stitches must be close enough together and accurate enough to keep the stuffing inside.

Key skills

- Design their own fruit bowl using an annotated sketch. Use this to create prototype templates.
- Use a template and pins to cut out material accurately.
- Select appropriate colour felt to create their desired fruit.
- Be able to thread a needle.
- Be able to tie a knot in the thread.
- Use running stitch to secure the materials.
- Evaluate their finished products based on design criteria.
