



## Unit 20: Les cadeaux (Presents)

### Learning outcomes

In this unit pupils will:

- ✓ Learn some words for presents in French
- ✓ They will learn how to ask for presents and be able to say what they will buy for other family members
- ✓ They will be able to thank someone for a gift and write gift tags, lists and letters
- ✓ They will use their previous knowledge, in a new context, in order to speak, read and write about the hobbies of family members

### End of unit product

- ✓ Letter to Santa
- ✓ List of presents to buy

### Prior learning

It is helpful if pupils already know:

- ✓ Numbers to 100
- ✓ Family members
- ✓ Some hobbies (unit 17)
- ✓ Colours
- ✓ Days of the week
- ✓ Some French names
- ✓ Letters of the alphabet
- ✓ *Je voudrais* (I would like)

### New language

Functions (purpose):

- ✓ Writing a letter, list
- ✓ Expressing opinions (about presents)
- ✓ Revising likes (about hobbies)
- ✓ Using repair strategies to keep a conversation going
- ✓ Prices - larger amounts
- ✓ Adjectives: used in metaphors

Grammar: (new and revision)

- ✓ Questions: using *Qu'est -ce que c'est?*
- ✓ Statements using *c'est ...*
- ✓ Requests : using *je voudrais*
- ✓ Plural indefinite article *des*
- ✓ Opinions: *je pense que...*
- ✓ Compound sentences with *mais* and *et*
- ✓ Adjectives agreement and position (revision)
- ✓ Comparatives: use of *trop, plus, moins*
- ✓ Future tense using *aller* + infinitive

Phonic focus:

- ✓ The alphabet (revision)
- ✓ Revision of key phonemes
- ✓ Pupils use phonic knowledge to attempt to pronounce unknown French words accurately
- ✓ Use knowledge of phoneme-grapheme correspondence to aid reading and writing
