



## Unit 22: Au café (At the cafe)

### Learning outcomes

In this unit pupils will:

- ✓ Learn to order a range of snacks and drinks
- ✓ Understand and justify likes and dislikes
- ✓ Learn to understand prices

### End of unit products

- ✓ Food song
- ✓ Written café dialogue, using a model
- ✓ Café role-play performance

### Prior learning

It is helpful if pupils already know:

- ✓ How to count in tens, 2s, etc
- ✓ Some food and drink items from previous units
- ✓ How to express likes and dislikes
- ✓ Greetings, please, thank you
- ✓ *Je voudrais*

### New language

Functions (purpose):

- ✓ Saying what you would like (ordering food)
- ✓ Asking what someone else would like
- ✓ Asking for the price
- ✓ Expressing and justifying opinions
- ✓ Number to 60, multiples of 10 to 100
- ✓ Using repair strategies to keep the conversation going

Grammar:

- ✓ Questions without inversion: *Vous désirez?*
- ✓ *C'est* + new adjectives
- ✓ Compound sentences with *et*
- ✓ Qualifying opinions with *parce que*
- ✓ Qualifiers: *très* and *trop*

Phonic focus:

- ✓ é as in sucré, salé, déquôtant and è as in très
- ✓ eu as in Euro
- ✓ tion as in addition
- ✓ ai as in voudrais
- ✓ silent last consonant as in tout

<a href="#">C'est combien?</a>	How much is it?
<a href="#">Ça fait combien?</a>	How much is it?

<a href="#">Qu'est-ce que tu as bu?</a>	What did you drink?
<a href="#">Qu'est-ce que tu as mangé?</a>	What did you eat?
<a href="#">J'ai bu</a>	I drank
<a href="#">J'ai mangé</a>	I ate

<a href="#">l'addition</a>	The bill
<a href="#">Vous désirez?</a>	What would you like?
<a href="#">Je voudrais ... s'il vous plaît.</a>	I would like ... please.
<a href="#">tout de suite</a>	straight away
<a href="#">Voilà!</a>	Here it is!

<a href="#">Pardon? Tu peux répéter?</a>	Sorry can you repeat that?
<a href="#">s'il te plaît</a>	please

### Additional language for teachers:

<a href="#">Super, bravo, très bien!</a>	super, great, very good!
<a href="#">Taisez-vous</a>	Be quiet
<a href="#">Écoutez/Écoute</a>	Listen (plural/singular)
<a href="#">Venez/Viens ici</a>	Come here (plural/singular)
<a href="#">Montrez/Montre-moi</a>	Show me (plural/singular)
<a href="#">Répétez/Répète</a>	Repeat (plural/singular)
<a href="#">Touchez/Touche l'image</a>	Touch (plural/singular) the picture
<a href="#">Répétez/Répète si c'est vrai</a>	Repeat (plural/singular) if it's true
<a href="#">Recommencez/Recommence</a>	Start (plural/singular) again
