



Unit 24 Destinations

Learning outcomes

In this unit pupils will:

- ✓ Learn names of countries in French
- ✓ Learn shape names
- ✓ Learn to describe nationality, where they are from and the language they speak
- ✓ Learn how to describe holiday plans
- ✓ Develop an understanding of stereotypes
- ✓ Develop awareness of francophone countries
- ✓ Explore other European languages

End of unit products

- ✓ A labelled map of European countries
- ✓ A description of holiday plans: destination, what they will see, eat and bring back

Prior learning

It is helpful if pupils already know:

- ✓ Colours
- ✓ About gender
- ✓ Some European countries (in English)
- ✓ How to form the future tense using *je vais* (met in Unit 17)

New language

Functions (purpose):

- ✓ Describing future plans about holiday destinations
- ✓ Describing what they will do
- ✓ Describing nationality, where they live and the language they speak
- ✓ Making simple statements about shapes and countries

Grammar:

- ✓ *en/ au / aux* + country; *à* + city
- ✓ Future tense: *aller* + infinitive (*je vais*)
- ✓ *être*: *je suis*
- ✓ *Où?* + inversion of verb and subject
- ✓ *C'est quel...? C'est où?*

Phonic focus:

- ✓ *eu* as in *Europe*
- ✓ *c* followed by *i* or *e* as in *cercle*
- ✓ silent last consonants *x* as in *croix*
- ✓ *an* sound in *triangle*, *Angleterre*
- ✓ *h* is silent as in *j'habite* i.e. when at the beginning of a word
- ✓ Liaison between final consonants when followed by a vowel e.g. in *États-Unis d'amérique*

Taisez-vous	Be quiet
Écoutez/Écoute	Listen (plural/singular)
Venez/Viens ici	Come here (plural/singular)
Montrez/Montre-moi	Show me (plural/singular)
Répétez/Répète	Repeat (plural/singular)
Touchez/Touche l'image	Touch (plural/singular) the picture
Répétez/Répète si c'est vrai	Repeat (plural/singular) if it's true
Recommencez/Recommence	Start (plural/singular) again
