



Linked learning theme: Cracking Coasts

Summer term, Year 5

Music – Pitch: scale of C, performing with boomwhackers

Prior knowledge

In Y4, children have developed their awareness of pitch and composed using the pentatonic scale. They have sung some simple rounds and canons.

Core knowledge

- A round (or canon) is a song sung in more than one part, where all the parts are the same but they begin at different times
- A scale is a sequence of notes in order of pitch. It can be played up or down.
- A chord is more than one note played or sung together.

Key skills

- Sing or play a part by ear.
- Sing a round or canon in tune and with expression, showing awareness of the other parts.
- Play tuned percussion instruments with increasing control, accuracy and fluency.
- Talk about notes played or sung together and the effects that are created.
- Use awareness of pitch to play by ear melodies based and control.
- Play boomwhackers with increasing accuracy and control.
- Sing or play a part by ear.
- Perform a part from simple notation.
- Perform a part in time with a group piece with awareness of the other parts.
- Talk about their performance and the effect of the group's performance.
