My child feels safe at this school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 100% agree/strongly agree- Despite incidents of challenging behaviour within school. Impact of behaviour policy and SLT presence, involvement with reflection and issuing of suspensions for more serious incidents.
The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 100% agree/strongly agree
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 18% agree/strongly agree that the school dealt with bullying issues quickly and effectively. ✓ 76% stated that their child has not been bullied ➤ 6% disagree/strongly disagree. Contradiction with 100% responses about safety/recommend to another parent. Could be a literal response to the question- my child has been bullied. Ensure that bullying allegations are always quickly identified by class teachers and effectively resolved and followed up.

Ensure that curriculum planning is well communicated. Possible new term class letter with planning overview. Website is updated and signposted.
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 92% agree/strongly agree ✓ 8% do not know. No responses in disagree/strongly disagree. Literal interpretation of the question possibly, if parents have not raised concerns the wording of the statement may indicate need for the 'don't know' answer.
The school has high expectations for my child.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 94% agree/strongly agree ➤ 5% do not know ➤ 1% disagree/strongly disagree- strengthening of parent/teacher relationships and communication avenues. Ensure expectations are communicated through parent evening meetings.
My child does well at this school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 99% response- agree/strongly agree ✓ 1% disagree/strongly disagree
The school lets me know how my child is doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 98% agree/strongly agree ➤ 2% disagree/strongly disagree. Ensure that opportunities are provided for dialogue/information about progress, possibly in addition to parents evening and school reports.
There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 96% agree/strongly agree ➤ 1% do not know ➤ 3% disagree/strongly disagree. Some comments about wider education and creative subjects. Explore how opportunities for forest school and art/DT can be provided within the curriculum.
My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 84% agree/strongly agree ➤ 12% do not know (parents of EYFS children where no club offer is available) ➤ 3% disagree/strongly disagree-comment about widening range of club offer. Staff to offer different club choices across each half term.
The school supports my child's wider personal development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 96% agree/strongly agree ➤ 2% do not know ➤ 1% disagree/strongly disagree- may be related to responses on range of subjects and clubs. Explore opportunities to broaden curriculum and club offer.
