## Art – Drawing Rod Biddulph (dinosaur illustrations)

### Prior knowledge

In EYFS, children have completed a range of drawings, experimenting with form, tone and texture.

### Core knowledge

- Drawing is a way of making a picture.
- Drawings are created by making lines on a surface.
- You can make many different marks on paper- sketching involves light pressure on the pencil/ a darker tone is created by adding more pressure to the pencil.
- Long lines make the shapes and short lines make the texture
- Drawings can be images of real life or abstract images
- Rob Biddulph is children’s author and illustrator (an illustrator draws pictures). His books include Happy Hatch Day and Lost and Found.

### Key skills

- Draw shapes and experiment with lines and tools (e.g. pencil, chalks, pastels etc.).
