Art – Kandinsky Arctic Collage

Prior Learning

In EYFS, children have learned about a range of artists. They know what an artist does and have started to offer opinions about what they like/dislike.

In EYFS children have experimented with a range of collage materials to represent ideas, thoughts and feelings.

Core knowledge

- Kandinsky was Russian and liked art and music. He loved colour and became famous for his abstract art.
- Abstract art achieves its effect using shapes, colours, and textures.
- Name one of Wassily Kandinsky famous paintings such as Swinging 1935, Composition VIII and Concentric Squares and Circles.
- Collage means to place different materials onto various surfaces

Key Skills

- Talk about the work of Kandinsky.
- Create a collage by cutting and sticking, crumpling etc.
- Talk about their ideas and the artwork they have created and suggest ways they can improve their work.
