Prior Learning

In EYFS, children have made observational drawings of plants and animals. Earlier in Year 1, children have created illustrations and other drawings.

Core knowledge

- Savannah Petrie uses lines and paint to draw.
- She is a local artist that came to Wheatcroft School.
- Observational drawings are drawings that you see, hear, smell, touch or taste.
- Light and shade are created by the pressure applied to my equipment.

Key Skills

- Talk about the work of Savannah Petrie and their own work.
- Draw what can be seen, not what I think is there.
- Experiment with line and tone and shading.
