



# Linked learning theme: I do like to be beside the sea

Summer term, Year 1 (6 to 8 weeks)

## Art – Sand/clay Sculpture

### Prior Learning

In EYFS, children have manipulated playdough, clay and sand by hand. They have created their own artwork and models.

### Core knowledge

- Sculpture is art in 3D
- Sculptures can be made by carving, modelling or placing materials together.
- They can be made out of stone, wool, clay or any other material the artist wants to use.

### Key skills

- Plan and talk about what will be made (taking inspiration from sculptures seen).
- Create a small clay sculpture.
- Create a sand sculpture, using other items from the beach to improve their work.
- Talk about and make improvements to the sculpture.
