Art – Observational Paintings- Scarborough Castle (group work)

Prior Learning

In EYFS children have made observational paintings of plant and animals. They have worked together to share ideas and resources.

Earlier in Year 1, children have experimented with colour mixing and painting.

Core knowledge (fact)

- Drawing is a way of making a picture.
- Drawings are created by making different lines on a surface.
- Long lines make the shapes and short lines make the texture
- Tone can be created by shading
- Drawings can be images of real-life objects or abstract images

Key skills (can do)

- Take own photographs of Scarborough castle and notice shape.
- Paint the shape of what can be seen.
- Mix/select colours to create areas of dark and light.
- Work as part of a group to create a large-scale castle painting.
