Art- Drawing (shading)

Prior knowledge

In year one children have been taught how to create different lines and shapes. They learned that you can make light and dark lines, depending on the pressure applied.

Core Knowledge

- Shading is the darkening or colouring of a picture using line or black colour.

Key skills

- Use sketchbook to explore and collect ideas.
- Use a variety of lines/ shapes/ marks to create a drawing.
- Sketch from real life objects and photos
- Use shading to create dark and light.
- Talk about their own work.
