Art – African Collage

Prior Learning

In year 1, children have created an arctic collage by cutting, tearing, crumpling etc.

Core knowledge

- A collage can be made up of lots of different materials.
- Items can be made by hand and can be beautiful/useful.
- Some materials are man-made and some are natural.
- Items can be joined together by using glue, sewing etc.
- Martin Bulinya is an African artist, raised amongst the Maasai tribe. His work is bright and mainly shows abstract Maasai figures.

- Use a sketchbook to explore ideas/ techniques.
- Create an African collage in the style of Martin Bulinya.
- Talk about their own work.
