



# Linked learning theme: Around the World

Autumn term, Year 3

## Art – Printing (Repeating pattern)

### Prior Learning

In Year 2, children created line drawing prints (using Safe Print).

### Core knowledge

- A print is an image created on one surface and transferred to another.
- A repeating print is the same print, one after the other.
- The pattern on the polystyrene must be simple and bold in order to print effectively.
- Printing requires printing ink, not paint.
- Equal pressure should be placed onto the polystyrene when printing so that the print is successful.

### Key skills

- Study printed art and discuss what is the same / different about the pieces.
- Use a sketchbook to explore and collect ideas.
- Create own simple design to print.
- Use tools effectively to indent the design onto polystyrene.
- Use a roller with the printing ink to create the printed design onto paper.
- Talk about own work.
