Art – Printing

Prior learning

In Y3, children have explored the art of people in history and used it to inspire their own work.

In Y2 and Y3, they have made simple print blocks by drawing into polystyrene sheets.

Core knowledge

- The Anglo Saxons were skilled craftspeople.
- Anglo Saxon monks used illuminated lettering to decorate their manuscripts.
- Printing can create multiple copies of the same image.

Key skills

- Observe examples of art and craft from the Anglo Saxon period and talk about Anglo Saxon patterns and design.
- Explore ideas and collect information to use in their work.
- Use line and pattern to create their own work inspired by Anglo Saxon design.
- Use printing techniques to create an effect.
