Art and design – Collage and paint – Mixed media

Prior Learning

In Year 5, children learned how to make a collage mood board (with various pictures, colours etc)

Children experienced working with acrylic paint techniques and methods of application.

Core knowledge

- Different techniques with the same material can achieve a range of effects.
- Understand that using different media together is called mixed media
- Materials can be layered one on top of the other to create depth and texture
- Colours/textures can be complimentary to each other

Key skills

- Use a sketchbook to explore and collect ideas
- Apply acrylic paint in a variety of techniques to achieve a range of effects.
- Layer materials to achieve a sense of three dimensional perspectives.
- Select the appropriate materials required to develop a desired texture.
