Art – Painting- Blitz skylines and silhouettes

Prior Knowledge

In year 5, children explored watercolours and talked about what worked well

Core knowledge

- More water can be used to create a paler effect, less water can be used to create a more vibrant look
- Silhouettes are created when light is behind an object.
- Colours can be blended to create the effect of fading light.
