



## Linked learning theme: Autumn term, Year 2

### Computing – Creating media – Digital photography

#### Prior Learning

- In Year 1, the children will have used buttons to produce an output and will build further on this learning. They will also have completed the IT around us module, exploring how devices can be used, and the digital painting module, which will have introduced the children to editing images.

#### Core knowledge

Learners will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

#### Key skills

- Use IT to capture images.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of portrait and landscape photos.
- Plan using composition to take high quality photos.
- Manipulate their environment, such as lighting, to take high quality photos.
- Adjust the colour of photos.
- Determine the authenticity of photos.
